3) What value does coaching and training bring to your clients?

Coaching, for me, is primarily about holding a space for my clients to grow. I am always mindful of providing them with a psychological safe space, a "cocoon", where they can undergo their transition before spreading their wings like a butterfly. This applies to both individual coaching, team coaching, and even training sessions. For me, coaching is a moment of full presence where biases and filters are set aside to reach a level of self-awareness where the coachee can observe themselves from a meta position and become able to accept and challenge themselves.

4) How do you work with your clients to ensure the perfect session?

Goal setting forms the backbone of my approach as it enables coachees to gauge their progress. I consistently revisit the intention with them: What drives their desire to receive coaching on this particular topic? What specific goals do they aim to achieve for themselves and their team through collective coaching? What motivates them to engage in the coaching process for their own personal growth? Focusing on the meaning is vital for me,
